



WEEK OF JANUARY 22-28, 2017

MONDAY

-  **Read** – John 14:6
-  **Do** – Jesus is the Way. Parents, hide a “treasure” (a special prize or package of candy) somewhere in the house, and tell your children to find the treasure. When they are unsuccessful, give them a map to the treasure. Jesus is like our “map” to the Kingdom of God. We can’t get to God without Him!
-  **Pray** – Praise God for providing Jesus as a way (THE Way) for us to get to Him.

TUESDAY

-  **Read** – John 14:6
-  **Do** – Jesus is the Truth. Play Two Truths and a Lie! Every person must tell two truths and one lie about themselves, and the other family members must guess which is the lie. We can’t always trust other people to tell the truth, but we can always count on God to be our Truth!
-  **Pray** – Thank God that He is Truth, and we can confidently believe every word in the Bible.

WEDNESDAY

-  **Read** – John 14:6
-  **Do** – Jesus is the Life. Draw a picture of your favorite place or activity. Talk about how Jesus is the source of all life—not just physical life, but spiritual life.
-  **Pray** – Thank God for giving us life—physical life each day, and spiritual life for those who have repented of their sin and placed their faith in Him.

THURSDAY

-  **Read** – John 14:6
-  **Do** – Blindfold one of your children and tell them they must get to another room in the house. They will either be too scared to move or will run into something! Now, try again, but this time, act as a guide. It’s only through Jesus that we can have a relationship with God.
-  **Pray** – Ask God to give you a desire for obedience.

FRIDAY

-  **Read** – John 14:6
-  **Do** – This week’s sermon was a reminder that Jesus is the ONLY WAY to be made right with God. Every person has a soul that will exist in Heaven or Hell. Take this opportunity to remind your children of the importance of having a relationship with God through Jesus. Share with them your testimony of how God called you out of darkness into His marvelous light!
-  **Pray** – Ask God to save specific lost people you know. Ask Him to give you courage to share the Gospel boldly with the people in your life. Pray for our church services on Sunday and for God to bring revival to CFBC!
