"Can We Trust the Bible?"




### DAY 1

-  **Read** – 2 Timothy 3:14
-  **Do** – Find a family recipe or ask a trusted friend for a good cookie recipe. Then have some fun baking cookies as a family! As you sit down to enjoy you're the fruits of your hard work, discuss with your children that the reason you could trust the recipe for delicious cookies was because of who gave it to you.
-  **Pray** – Thank God that we can trust the Bible because He is the one who protected it and gave it to us.

### DAY 2

-  **Read** – 2 Timothy 3:15
-  **Do** – [Follow this Link](#) and write down the different books of the Bible with their Christ connection on individual slips of paper. Depending on the age of your children, help them put the books in order, or have them race to put them in order. Afterwards, take turns reading the Christ connections for each book and discussing them.
-  **Pray** – Praise God that He reveals His plan to save us throughout the Bible!

### DAY 3

-  **Read** – 2 Timothy 3:16
-  **Do** – Read 2 Timothy 3:16 and have a blank sheet of paper close by. Ask your children to listen for what the Bible is useful for and then write down their answers. Then help them to write down Pastor's definitions for these words and discuss how the Bible does each:
  - Teaching: It teaches us what is right.
  - Reproof: It teaches us what is not right.
  - Correction: It teaches how to get right.
  - Training in righteousness: It teaches us how to stay right.
-  **Pray** – Ask God to help your family build your lives around the Word of God in 2017
