“God Alone Deserves Our Glory!”

DAY 1: God’s Glory in His Word

- Read** – 1 Timothy 1:17
- Do** – Memorize 1 Timothy 1:17 as a family. Have each family member write it on a sheet of paper and place it somewhere you’ll all see it, such as on the refrigerator or the bathroom mirror. Consider saying it every time you eat together or buckle up in the car!
- Pray** – Praise God for the Bible, where He tells us all about who He is. Ask Him to help your family understand His Word better and seek Him with your whole hearts!

DAY 2: God’s Glory in the World

- Read** – Psalm 19:1
- Do** – When God created the world, He designed it to show His glory! Spend some time going on a Nature Scavenger Hunt as a family. Make a list of things and animals you might see outside. (For example, trees, fall leaves, sunset, deer, stars, dog...) Now, go on a walk or a car ride as a family and see how many things on your list you can find! Talk about how each thing in nature reminds us of its Creator.
- Pray** – Praise God for everything you found on your Nature Scavenger Hunt!

DAY 3: God’s Glory in You!

- Read** – Hebrews 7:23-24
- Do** – Review what we learned on Day Two—that God’s creation gives Him glory by doing what He created it to do. What was the final thing God created in Genesis 1? Us! By being what He made us to be, we give God glory and point the world to Him. God created us to exist in relationship with each other in families. So tonight, do your FAVORITE thing together as a family! As you enjoy time together, praise God for creating us to live life together in families.
- Pray** – Thank God for showing the world His glory through us!
