



WEEK OF FEBRUARY 5-11, 2017

“Eternal Security is in Christ Alone!”

MONDAY

- Read** – Matthew 26:26-29
- Do** – What is the Lord’s Supper and its purpose? Talk about this with your kids! Jesus commanded us to take the Lord’s Supper to remember His death, burial, and resurrection. We remember that He died so that we could be forgiven. We remember His promise to give believers eternal life. And we will continue to have this meal together until He returns!
- Pray** – Praise God for the beautiful reminder of the Lord’s Supper. Pray as a family for the salvation of your children.

TUESDAY

- Read** – Hebrews 7:22
- Do** – With your kids, take a heavy object (even a child!) and attempt to tape it to the wall using Scotch tape. It won’t hold! Now, use a roll of Duct Tape to do the same thing. It holds! We can’t trust in our own works for salvation—only Jesus is strong enough to save!
- Pray** – Thank God that He is the only One strong enough to save us!

WEDNESDAY

- Read** – Hebrews 7:23-24
- Do** – On one side of a piece of paper, use a pencil to draw a cross. On the other side, use a pen to draw a cross. Now, try an eraser on both crosses. The pencil disappears, but the pen remains! In Jesus, our salvation is **permanent**. There is nothing we can do to take it away!
- Pray** – Praise God together that, once we are His, we are His forever!

THURSDAY

- Read** – Hebrews 7:25
- Do** – Just as Jesus has the power to save us and the privilege to intercede, parents have the ability to be there to strengthen their children and the privilege to pray for and encourage them. As a picture of this for little kids, have them stand on the table and jump into your arms!
- Pray** – Thank God that Jesus has the power to save us and intercede for us.

FRIDAY

- Read** – Hebrews 7:26-28
- Do** – Jesus didn’t die for us because he *had* to; He died because He *wanted* to! Read or recite John 3:16 as a family, but replace “the world” with your children’s names. Jesus coming to earth to die for us was an expression of His great love for us.
- Pray** – Praise God that He loves us so much He willingly died for us! Pray for our church services tomorrow. Ask Him to bring revival to CFBC!
