WEEK OF MAY 7-13, 2017
"Pray like it matters!"



DAY 1:

-  **Read** – Acts 1:12-26
-  **Pray** – The disciples prioritized prayer before they did anything! Pray for our church family. Pray that we will have a passion for Jesus, that we will be in harmony with one another, that we will be fully devoted to Jesus, and that we will be confident in God's power.



DAY 2:

-  **Read** – Psalm 100
-  **Pray** – Teach your kids a simple way to pray using the acronym ACTS: Adoration (praising God), Confession (confessing sin), Thanksgiving (thanking God for specific blessings), Supplication (praying for specific requests). You can pray this way every day!



DAY 3:

-  **Read** – Romans 3:23; Romans 6:23; Romans 5:8; Romans 10:9-10, 13
-  **Pray** – Parents, pray for salvation for your children. If everyone in your immediate family is already a believer, who can you pray salvation for that you know? Pray they will be saved, and pray that God will make you attentive to opportunities He gives you to share the hope of Jesus with them.

DAY 4:

-  **Read** – Matthew 28:18-20
-  **Pray** – Pray for God's Kingdom to come to the earth! Ask Him how you can be a part of His plan in bringing people to know Him. Pray that He will give you open eyes to see the needs of people around you—most of all, their spiritual need of salvation through Jesus Christ alone!

DAY 5:

-  **Read** – 1 Timothy 2:1-2
-  **Pray** – Pray for authorities in your lives. Ask your children what authorities they have in their lives. (School teachers, coaches, government, etc.) Point out that parents are their authority, as well! Teach them to pray for the authorities in their lives, and allow them to pray for you, their parents. End in praying for our pastor and our church services tomorrow. Pray for God to continue to bring revival to CFBC!
