CFBC Prayer Guide - May 13 to June 30

BEGIN WITH WORSHIP AND CONFESSION

Praise God with all your heart.

Psalm 9:1-2 - I will give thanks to the Lord with all my heart; I will tell of all Your wonders. I will be glad and exult in You; I will sing praise to Your name, O Most High.

Praise God for His help, protection, and deliverance.

Psalm 28:6-7 - Blessed be the Lord, Because He has heard the voice of my supplication. The Lord is my strength and my shield; My heart trusts in Him, and I am helped; Therefore my heart exults, And with my song I shall thank Him.

Exalt Jesus for He is Truth.

John 14:6 - Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.

Praise Jesus, for He is Supreme.

Deuteronomy 10:17 - For the Lord your God is the God of gods and the Lord of lords, the great, the mighty, and the awesome God who does not show partiality nor take a bribe.

Be open to spiritual examination and confession.

James 4:10 - Humble yourselves in the presence of the Lord, and He will exalt you.

PRAY FOR OUR CHURCH

Pray that our pastor and staff will be filled with the knowledge of God's will.

Colossians 1:9 - For this reason also, since the day we heard of it, we have not ceased to pray for you and to ask that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding,

Pray that our pastor and staff will walk in faith.

2 Corinthians 5:7 - for we walk by faith, not by sight—

Pray that our pastor and staff will stand in the center of God's will.

Colossians 4:12 - Epaphras, who is one of your number, a bondslave of Jesus Christ, sends you his greetings, always laboring earnestly for you in his prayers, that you may stand perfect and fully assured in all the will of God.

Pray that our pastor and staff will let the word of Christ dwell richly in them.

Colossians 3:16 - Let the word of Christ richly dwell within you, with all wisdom teaching and admonishing one another with psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with thankfulness in your hearts to God.

Pray that God would lead us to the right persons to be our Active Families Pastor, Tech Director, and Director of Student Girls' Ministry.

Isaiah 6:8 - 8 Then I heard the voice of the Lord, saying, "Whom shall I send, and who will go for Us?" Then I said, "Here am I. Send me!"

Acts 21:2 - And when they heard it they began glorifying God; and they said to him, "You see, brother, how many thousands there are among the Jews of those who have believed, and they are all zealous for the Law;

Pray that every participant at our camps and BKCs will walk away knowing that God's Word is for their guidance.

Psalm 119:105 - Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.

Ask that every participant in these summer ministries will be prepared to hear God's Word and allow the Holy Spirit to work in them.

Psalm 51:10-12 - Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me. Do not cast me away from Your presence and do not take Your Holy Spirit from me. Restore to me the joy of Your salvation and sustain me with a willing spirit.

Ask God to create within the hearts of our summer ministry participants an expectancy of renewal, growth, healing, changed lives, and eyes and ears open to the truth of God's Word.

Isaiah 43:19 - "Behold, I will do something new, now it will spring forth; will you not be aware of it? I will even make a roadway in the wilderness, rivers in the desert.

Pray that kids, students, and adults will respond to the Gospel with repentance and faith, and that the Gospel will be proclaimed at our camps and BKCs.

Acts 3:19 - Therefore, repent and return, so that your sins may be wiped away, in order that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord.

PRAY FOR OUR CHURCH PLANT, THE MANOR COMMUNITY CHURCH (Our Church Plant Outside Arlington)

Pray that God will give the church planter (Jay Stephenson) wisdom and discernment as he navigates the many challenges of starting a new ministry. Pray that God will go before them and prepare the hearts of those who will be a part of this new church.

Matthew 13:33 - He spoke another parable to them, "The kingdom of heaven is like leaven, which a woman took and hid in three pecks of flour until it was all leavened."

Pray that God will gather a strong core group (the church's founding members) in order to reach their neighbors and community.

Luke 10:2 - And He was saying to them, "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; therefore, beseech the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest.

Pray for open doors of opportunity for the church planter and the core group to connect with the right people, find suitable locations, and receive the resources they need to establish a vibrant and impactful church. Remove any obstacles and barriers that stand in their way.

1 Corinthians 16:9 - For a wide door for effective service has opened to me, and there are many adversaries.

Pray for God's provision of adequate financial support.

Philippians 4:19 - And my God will supply all your needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.
