BEGIN WITH WORSHIP AND CONFESSION

Praise God, for He Is the Omnipotent

Isaiah 40:28-29- Do you not know? Have you not heard? The Everlasting God, the LORD, the Creator of the ends of the earth does not become weary or tired. His understanding is inscrutable. He gives strength to the weary, and to him who lacks might He increases power.

Praise God, for He Is Omniscient

Psalms 139:1-4 - O LORD, You have searched me and known me. ²You know when I sit down and when I rise up; You understand my thought from afar. ³You scrutinize my path and my lying down And are intimately acquainted with all my ways. ⁴Even before there is a word on my tongue, Behold, O Lord, You know it all.

Praise God, for He Is Omnipresent

Psalms 139:7-8 - Where can I go from Your Spirit? Or where can I flee from Your presence? ⁸If I ascend to heaven, You are there; If I make my bed in Sheol, behold, You are there.

Spend Some Time in Spiritual Examination and Confession

James 4:10 –Humble yourselves in the presence of the Lord, and He will exalt you.

PRAY FOR OUR FAMILIES

Pray for Our Marriage Conference to Spur Husbands and Wives to Love Each Other More and Communicate in Positive Ways

Hebrews 13:4 - Marriage is to be held in honor among all, and the marriage bed is to be undefiled; for fornicators and adulterers God will judge.

Request That the Lord Would Give Each Member of the Family a Genuine Love for Others

1 Peter 4:8 - Above all, keep fervent in your love for one another, because love covers a multitude of sins.

Entreat the Lord That Your Family's Hearts and Minds Would Be Protected from the Negative Influences and Sin in the World.

Proverbs 4:23 - Watch over your heart with all diligence, for from it flow the springs of life.

Ask God to Help Your Family Persevere with Courage Through Hard Times; To Be Strong and Courageous

Deuteronomy 31:6 – “Be strong and courageous, do not be afraid or tremble at them, for the LORD your God is the one who goes with you. He will not fail you or forsake you.”

Pray That Each Member of Your Family Would Walk in Wisdom at Every Age

James 1:5 - But if any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all generously and without reproach, and it will be given to him.

Request That the Lord Would Give Your Children Obedient Hearts Toward You as Parents, and That All of Your Family Would Seek to Obey God

Psalms 128:1 - How blessed is everyone who fears the LORD, who walks in His ways.

Implore God for His Guidance in All of Your Family's Plans and Decisions

Proverbs 16:9 - The mind of man plans his way, but the Lord directs his steps.

Pray That Our Families Would Be Gracious and Generous to Others

1 Timothy 6:18 - Instruct them to do good, to be rich in good works, to be generous and ready to share.

Ask That Your Family Would Seek and Respond to Chances to Serve and Bless Others

Proverbs 11:25 - The generous man will be prosperous, and he who waters will himself be watered.

Pray That Your Family's Example Would Point Others Toward God.

Matthew 5:16 - Let your light shine before men in such a way that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father who is in heaven.

PRAY FOR OUR CHURCH

Pray for Our Staff to Fulfill Their Responsibilities as Shepherds

Acts 20:28 - Be on guard for yourselves and for all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which He purchased with His own blood.

Ask That Our Staff Receives Their Due Respect from the Church

1 Timothy 5:17-19 - The elders who rule well are to be considered worthy of double honor, especially those who work hard at preaching and teaching. ¹⁸ For the Scripture says, "YOU SHALL NOT MUZZLE THE OX WHILE HE IS THRESHING," and "The laborer is worthy of his wages." ¹⁹ Do not receive an accusation against an elder except on the basis of two or three witnesses.

Pray for Our Staff, Leaders, and Volunteers to Have a Servant Attitude

Mark 10:42-45 - Calling them to Himself, Jesus said to them, "You know that those who are recognized as rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them; and their great men exercise authority over them. ⁴³ But it is not this way among you, but whoever wishes to become great among you shall be your servant; ⁴⁴ and whoever wishes to be first among you shall be slave of all. ⁴⁵ For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."

Ask God That Our Members Would Be Good Examples for Others

1 Corinthians 11:1 - Be imitators of me, just as I also am of Christ.

Pray That Our Church Would Be Generous Givers

Luke 6:38 - Give, and it will be given to you. They will pour into your lap a good measure—pressed down, shaken together, and running over. For by your standard of measure it will be measured to you in return."

Ask the Lord for Our Church to Learn How to Pray without Giving Up

Luke 18:1 - Now He was telling them a parable to show that at all times they ought to pray and not to lose heart.

Pray That Our Church Would Live in Unity with Other Believers

John 17:20-21 - "I do not ask on behalf of these alone, but for those also who believe in Me through their word; ²¹ that they may all be one; even as You, Father, are in Me and I in You, that they also may be in Us, so that the world may believe that You sent Me."
