BEGIN WITH WORSHIP AND CONFESSION

Praise God for His Greatness

Psalm 48:1 – Great is the LORD, and greatly to be praised, in the city of our God, His holy mountain.

Praise God for His Strength and Power

Psalm 73:26 – My flesh and my heart may fail, but God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever.

Exalt God for He Is Sovereign

Psalm 115:3 – But our God is in the heavens; He does whatever He pleases.

Praise Jesus, for He Is the Suffering Servant

Mark 10:45 – For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many.

Be Open to Spiritual Examination and Confession

James 4:10 – Humble yourselves in the presence of the Lord, and He will exalt you.

PRAY FOR OUR NATION

Pray That Our Leaders Will Fear God

Proverbs 9:10 – The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom, and the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding.

Ask the Lord to Show Our President and Congressmen How to Consider Themselves as Servants to a Higher Power; the American Government Has Been Ordained by God

Romans 13:1 – Let every person be subject to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and those that exist have been instituted by God.

Beg the Lord to Continue to Be Patient with Our Nation

2 Peter 3:9 – The Lord is not slow about His promise, as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing for any to perish but for all to come to repentance.

Pray for Revival in the Church and in Your Home

2 Chronicles 7:14 – And if My people who are called by My name humble themselves and pray and seek My face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, will forgive their sin and will heal their land.

Pray for a Spiritual Awakening to Begin in Your Neighborhood and That God Uses You as a Catalyst to Bring It

Psalm 105:1 – Oh give thanks to the Lord, call upon His name; make known His deeds among the peoples.

Pray for a Spiritual Awakening in Our Nation

John 3:16 – For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life.

PRAY FOR OUR CHURCH

Pray for Our Church to Be One as the Father and Jesus Are One

John 17:21 - That they may all be one; even as You, Father, are in Me and I in You, that they also may be in Us, so that the world may believe that You sent Me.

Ask for Our Unity to Reflect a Commitment of Love to Each Other

Philippians 2:1-2 - ¹Therefore if there is any encouragement in Christ, if there is any consolation of love, if there is any fellowship of the Spirit, if any affection and compassion, ²make my joy complete by being of the same mind, maintaining the same love, united in spirit, intent on one purpose.

Pray That You and Your Fellow Church Members Will Abide in Christ

John 15:5 – I am the vine, you are the branches; he who abides in Me and I in him, he bears much fruit, for apart from Me you can do nothing.

Ask God to Give Us a Desire to Be Obedient

Psalms 40:8 - I delight to do Your will, O my God; Your Law is within my heart.

Pray for God to Bring Reconciliation, Healing, and Forgiveness to Broken Relationships in Our Church

Ephesians 4:32 - Be kind to one another, tender-hearted, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you.

Pray That Our Pastor and Staff Will Have Their Strength Renewed After a Busy Summer

Isaiah 40:31 – Yet those who wait for the Lord will gain new strength; they will mount up with wings like eagles, they will run and not get tired, they will walk and not become weary.

Pray for Our Pastor as He Studies the Word and for His Proclamation of the Word

2 Timothy 2:15 – Be diligent to present yourself approved to God as a workman who does not need to be ashamed, accurately handling the word of truth.

Pray That God Would Lead Us to the Right People for Our Student Ministry

1 Timothy 3:1-2 – ¹It is a trustworthy statement: if any man aspires to the office of overseer, it is a fine work he desires to do. ²An overseer, then, must be above reproach, the husband of one wife, temperate, prudent, respectable, hospitable, able to teach.”

Pray for Our Marriage Conference, September 14, That God Would Strengthen and Revive Marriages That Work for the Good of Our Families and Glorify Him

Mark 10:9 – What therefore God has joined together, let no man separate.

Pray That God Will Be Glorified and for People to Respond to the Gospel Through Our Special Needs Camp (Camp Champ July 14-17) and Camp Kickstart (July 31)

Acts 21:20 – And when they heard it they began glorifying God; and they said to him, “You see, brother, how many thousands there are among the Jews of those who have believed, and they are all zealous for the Law.”
